Accommodation

Toužim Airfield is located in a remote area of western Bohemia, aprox. 20km SSE of Karlovy Vary (LKKV). Accommodation possibilities are limited in the close area surrounding the airfield. We therefore recommend securing a place for your stay as soon as possible.

There will be a temporary campsite on the airfield, close to the glider parking area, with the usual facilities e.g., non-drinking water, showers, toilets and electrical hook-ups.

The accommodation fee at the camping site at the airfield will be 200 Kč per person per night.

Meals

There will be light food services provided at the airfield in the form of breakfast and dinner. Breakfast will be served from 8.00am until 9.30am and dinner from 17.00 until 19.00.

Breakfast: 120,- CZK

Dinner: 170,- + 30,- CZK (main+soup)

Please indicate your interest in airfield-based dining at the registration form.

There are alternative dining options in the surrounding towns.

Local Procedures (extract)

Competition Classes

The Czech Gliding Championship will be held in the following classes (according to the Czech Competition Code, Czech Index List will be used)

- Club Class
- 15M Combi Class
- OPEN Combi Class

Additional safety rules

All competing gliders must be fitted with a serviceable industry-standard anti-collision system. The system must be in operation during all competition flights.

Contest Area

The contest area includes the territories of the Czech Republic, Austria and Germany.

The Contest Area Altitude limit is FL95. More details will be published in Self Briefing

and daily briefings. Please ensure your third-party insurance covers territories of all mentioned countries.

Entry fee and aero-tow fees

Entry Fee: CZK 6.500,-

Aero-tow to 600 metres AAL

Club class: CZK 850,-Combi Classes: CZK 950,-Self-launching gliders self-launch fee: CZK 150,-

Bank account details for payment will be published in Bulletin ver. 2. Entry fee is due together with the registration form by March 31st, 2024.

Total number of allowed entries

The total number of allowable entries shall not exceed 100 in total, with a maximum of 50 in each class.

Insurance

Third-Party Insurance for Gliders

Third-party insurance meeting the requirements of EC Regulation 785/2004 is required for each participating glider.

The minimum third-party liability insurance for single-seat gliders with certified MTOM < 500kg is 750,000 Special Drawing Rights (SDR), and for MTOM < 1.000kg is SDR 1,500,000.

Documentary proof of insurance must be provided in the Czech or English language and provided by pilots during registration.

Personal Medical Insurance

Personal medical insurance (covering accidents and sickness, including any hospital costs and transportation back to the team member's country of residence) is required.

Documentary proof of insurance must be provided in the Czech or English language and provided by pilots during registration.

TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

Mandatory additional equipment

Audio variometers must be fitted and used in all gliders.

All flight instruments, PDAs, GPS, navigators, flight computers etc. must be firmly mounted in the glider in such a way that the pilot's vision is not restricted.

High visibility markings are not required.

FR calibration certificates are not required. However, to be considered by the Scorer, any calibration certificate presented must be current according to SC3 2.4.6.

Radio Communications

Due to radio frequency congestion in the European airspace, the organizer together with authorities will allocate several radio frequencies with 8.33kHz spacing for use by pilots during the championships.

All glider radios and ground station radios must be approved 8.33kHz compliant radios.

Use of radio frequencies other than official gliding frequencies and published team frequencies for team communications will be strictly prohibited.

List of frequencies will be present before the Competition.

Emergency Frequency: 121.500kHz (monitored by ATC)
